Beginner/Refresher Courses are structured to develop key skills in each discipline. No prior experience of printmaking is needed.

Intermediate Courses give a more in depth understanding of techniques and processes. Focused on professional workshop practice, improving competency and building confidence. Only suitable for people with recent experience or who have passed a beginner class in their chosen discipline.

Advanced Courses aimed at the experienced printmaker and for those who have attended our Beginner/Refresher and Intermediate courses.

One-Day, Tasters, and Introduction to Printmaking Course are aimed at people who are new to printmaking or who want to try out a technique to find out how it's done before committing to a full weekend or evening course. Also suitable for printmakers or people who want to develop new skills.

Please be advised that One-Day, Taster courses and Intro to Printmaking courses do not provide sufficient experience to join the workshop as an independent member. If you are interested in membership, please see dedicated courses in the discipline.

We will be joining forces again with Glasgow Press and Print Clan to offer **Print, Press, Pull: Three Saturdays, Three Studios, Three Techniques.** Each week will provide an introduction to one of the studios and give the chance to use the specialist facilities, exploring letterpress, textile, and paper screenprinting techniques.

Screenprint & Bookbinding – Short Taster Course *NEW

Discover the art of Screenprinting and Bookbinding in this engaging, skill-sharing weekend course. On Saturday, tutor Rosalind Lawless will guide you through screen preparation, image separations, and experimental mark-making, using a blend of stencil-based, and monoprint techniques to produce unique patterned papers. On Sunday, dive into bookbinding with Kerry Douglas, where you will learn to craft two different book formats, a lay-flat coptic bound sketchbook and an A5 hardbound journal. Alongside learning two bindings, you'll also make perfectly fitting hard covers, completing two bespoke books filled with your own prints.

Monoprint and Chine Colle with Lin Chau - Beginners/Refresher

This two day course will introduce you to mono print and chine-colle processes. You will learn how to make the dough and the process of paste using wheat powder and plain flour for chine-colle. Following a demonstration by Lin, you will produce your own monoprints to use to create chine-colle prints to take home. Suitable for beginners, no experience required.

Introduction to Woodcut - Beginner/Refresher

During this course you will learn how to transfer your image onto Japanese plywood and experiment with woodcutting tools to create a variety of line and textured effects. Various inking techniques will be demonstrated and you will learn about registration, setting the pressure, and correct use of the Columbian Eagle Press to produce a small edition of woodcut prints.

Woodcut:Intermediate

Reduction. Multi Block and Lasercut course *NEW

Over this 7-week course, guided by Al Gow, you will look at reduction and multi-block woodcut printing on a small and large scale. You will use two different registration systems ("L" jig and pin and tab), Columbian and etching presses and explore different options for making and printing woodcuts. There will be a focus on professional practice, keeping cutting tools sharp, ink and colour and an option to use the laser cutter to expand on hand-cutting techniques. Participants will be provided with an A4 block and 2 larger blocks to realise at least two images. Additional blocks and materials may be purchased during the course. Tools will be provided but participants are welcome to bring their own cutting tools. Previous relief printing experience required.

Screenprinting - Advanced

This course is aimed at the experienced screenprinter who wishes to develop existing skills. Through a project-based weekend, which will cover advanced techniques including utilising manual and found positives, conventional film positives and digital positives. You will work with direct stencil based imaging, washout method, paper stencils and C.M.Y.K print techniques.

Introduction to Mezzotint - Beginner/Refresher

Working in monochrome & colour you will be introduced to a variety of mark making techniques exploring this beautiful & unique process. Learn how to produce, register and print multi plate colour images. Suitable for all skill levels- a modicum of patience is required for this labour intensive process.

Introduction to Collagraphy - Beginner/Refresher

Using the low-tech medium of collagraph, prepare plates using a variety of materials to build up layers and textures, experiment with inking, and print in monotone and colour.

Etching uses acid to cut images into a metal plate, which is then inked and printed through a press. Learn the basics and explore this technique using soft grounds, hard grounds and aquatint to produce richly textured images.

Introduction to Photo Etching - Intermediate

An experimental 2 day course which will explore the principles of photo etching. Part of the course will be spent preparing artwork to expose onto plates. This will be done using computers and hand drawn processes. You will learn how to coat and expose photo etching plates and produce final prints. Experience of etching and basic computer skills are required.

Introduction to Photopolymer with Leena Nammari - Intermediate

Photo polymer etching is one of the least toxic accessible intaglio techniques. Using water as the developer, and photographs as your starting point, this course will cover basic Photoshop manipulation, printing out the images onto acetate, test stripping, developing and printing the A5 plate. As with all introductory courses, there will be no masterpieces made on the course, the aim is to learn the process. This course is aimed at those who have previous attended the Beginners/Refresher Etching course or have equivalent experience. Previous photoshop experience is preferred. And please if you have one, bring a laptop with image & Photoshop installed.


